Sales Decline - What does it mean?

Each month we put together a [What's Trending](#) infographic for a quick look at what is happening in our local real estate market.

The number of homes sales dropped over 11% since the same time last year. That would normally sound like a bad thing...declining sales is not a great indication of a strong market.

However, the issue for Orlando is still lack of inventory! Each month in 2018 there have been approximately 7500-7750 homes for sale. About 45% of the market is selling each month and the number of new listings just cannot keep up with the number being sold. While this is great if you are selling, it can make things really difficult for buyers.
